

PIUTE HIGH SCHOOL GENERAL INFORMATION

Please read through this general information packet carefully, you will need to be aware of the following items:

- School begins August 26, 2020, at 8:00 am. School will be a HALF day on this day. A FULL day of school will begin on August 27th at 8:00 am and end at 3:00 pm. A calendar is included with this letter. Please keep this calendar in a visible place in case a question arises. This year, Fridays will be half days with school beginning at 8:00 am and ending at noon.
- Payment for school meals can be made at the office or online. ***Lunch will not be given on credit and students need to pay in advance. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.*** Students will be allowed ONLY ONE meal on credit. Once your student(s) use all of their lunch money, they will only be allowed to eat once before money must be brought to school. We will not let them eat the following day if they have not paid for lunches. We encourage you to pay by the month. Full pay students average \$42.00 monthly for lunch and \$26.25 monthly for breakfast; the money can add up quickly so please keep current with your payments. ***Free and Reduced Lunch Applications*** should be completed online with online registration. The price of breakfast and lunch are as follows: Breakfast cost is \$1.25 and lunch is \$2.25. Reduced price breakfast is \$.30 and lunch is \$.40.
- Credit will not be given for bookstore items, shop projects, etc. Please send the necessary money with your student for notebooks, pencils, etc. If you qualify for the ***Standard Fee Waiver***, expenses relating to academics will be covered. ***For a list of ALL school fees, please refer to the enclosed Fee Schedule.***
- ***Students, grades 7-9, will be given an iPad – Generation 7 with an included keyboard case. Students, grades 10-12, will be given a MacBook Air with case. NO CASES WILL NEED TO BE PURCHASED!***
- ***ONLINE REGISTRATION MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE STUDENTS WILL BE GIVEN A TECHNOLOGY DEVICE!*** Instructions for completing online registration can be found on the district website: www.piutek12.org.
- Preferably, student cars should not be driven to school. Please use transportation provided by the school district. The school campus is a closed campus, mandated by the Piute County School Board. Students should not leave campus for any reason without permission of the principal or from office personnel.
- ***All 7th grade students are required to have a physical examination.***
- The State of Utah requires each athlete to receive a physical EVERY year and each parent to register their athlete(s) with the state BEFORE beginning the season! Each parent can now register his/her athlete(s) for EVERY sport he/she plans on playing through the entire school year. The link to register your student (and download a

- All students who compete in interscholastic competition must be covered by insurance or parents must agree to a waiver of insurance found on RegisterMyAthlete.com. It is recommended that the student be covered by his or her own family group policy, however, if such is not available, insurance may be purchased through the school. If a student is covered by a family policy, please provide verification of insurance to the office prior to competition.
- Please pay attention to the Piute County School District Dress Code. The dress code has changed to allow hats on a trial basis. See the dress code policy for more information.
